What is Webelos Woods? Webelos Woods is an outdoor activity program designed to aid in the transition from Cub Scouts to Boy Scouts. This fun-filled weekend will showcase the amazing possibilities that lie ahead, and is designed to inspire Webelos to find a “best fit” Troop. While Webelos experience the thrills of Boy Scouting, their accompanying adults gain a perspective on Troop programming and future opportunities for themselves.

Who can attend? All Pacifica District Webelos Scouts are invited to participate, but each Scout **must** be accompanied by their parent, guardian or family member over 18 years of age. All adults should have current YPT training (completed after February 1st, 2018). Due to the limited size of this event, we ask that no siblings attend.

Where is it? El Dorado East Regional Park, 7550 E Spring St, Long Beach, CA 90815

When is it? September 28-30, 2018

Friday check-in starts at 5pm so you can set up camp and eat a leisurely dinner. Scouts will begin patrol activities at 7:30, while adults learn about the Webelos to Scout transition. Lights out at 10pm!

Saturday starts with hot breakfast and an opening bridging ceremony at 8am. Activity stations for patrols begin at 9am and run until lunch, when we'll take a break to eat and visit Troop exhibits on the midway. The afternoon features more activity stations and a free period to allow for more midway visits. After a tasty dinner, it's time for the fun and camaraderie of campfire. With such a busy day, you'll be ready for lights out at 10!

Sunday We'll start our day with a brief interfaith service to honor our Duty to God. Then it's time to thank the staff, break camp, grab a quick breakfast, and check out by 10am.

Cost: Early bird price is **\$40.00** per person if received by **Friday, August 24, 2018**, or \$50.00 per person thereafter. Includes meals (except Friday night), scarf, patch and all activities and crafts.

NOTE: Vehicle admission charge (\$6 on Fridays or \$7 on weekends—CASH ONLY) is NOT included in your registration. Participants may wish to carpool and should plan to stay for the entire event. PARK GATES CLOSE TO CAR AND FOOT TRAFFIC AT 8:00PM and re-open at 7:00am.

Make sure to fill out all forms completely and sign and date them. You will NOT be allowed to stay at camp without them!

If we cannot accommodate your dietary restrictions, we'll let you know, but please note that your registration is a flat fee and cannot be pro-rated.

El Dorado East Regional Park
7550 E Spring St
Long Beach, CA 90815

1. Take I-405 South
2. Exit Bellflower Blvd South
3. Turn left onto E Los Coyotes Diagonal
4. Turn right onto E Spring St
5. Turn left into El Dorado East Regional Park
6. Park in the lot just north of the Youth Group Campground.
7. All activities will be in the Youth Group Campground area.

NOTE: Vehicles must pay a CASH ONLY admission charge to the park on entry. (\$6 on Fridays or \$7 on weekends). Participants may wish to carpool and should plan to stay for the entire event. Park gates close to car and foot traffic at 8:00pm and re-open at 7:00am. Cars may exit only at any time via the Wardlow Rd gate to the north of the park.
