

National Youth Leader Training Code of Conduct

All Youth and Adult participants of National Youth Leadership Training are representatives of the community, family and local Scouting Council. Therefore, all Youth and their parents are asked to sign this Code of Conduct and Statement of Understanding as a condition for participating with the further understanding, that serious misconduct or infraction of behavior rules may result in expulsion from the NYLT course. We want each youth to be responsible for their own behavior, and only when necessary will the procedure be invoked to send a youth home from NYLT.

ALL YOUTH ARE EXPECTED TO LIVE BY THE SCOUT OATH AND LAW AT ALL TIMES AND TO USE THESE IDEALS AS GUIDES FOR THEIR BEHAVIOR.

- I promise on my honor as a Scout that I will set a good example by keeping myself neatly dressed and presentable. The Scout uniform will be worn at all times as designated by the Scoutmaster.
- I will be responsible for keeping my tent and personal gear labeled, clean and neat.
- I will demonstrate respect for the Course equipment, public property and will be personally responsible for cleanliness and any loss, breakage, or vandalism of property.

Serious or repetitive behavior violations by youth including, but not limited to, the possession or use of tobacco, alcohol, fireworks, or cheating, gambling, dishonesty, swearing, fighting, and cursing may result in the expulsion from the National Youth Leadership Training. Scouts must learn to respect the rights and property of others. Remember to keep your hands to yourself. The tongue is a vicious weapon, think before you speak. Remember the golden rule, "Do To Others As You Would Have Them Do To You."

I PROMISE ON MY HONOR AS A SCOUT THAT I WILL DO MY BEST TO LIVE UP TO THE SCOUT OATH AND LAW AND AGREE TO FOLLOW THIS CODE OF CONDUCT.
