For Cubs and Webelos: The opportunity to complete Advancement Requirements for various Rank Adventures such as:

Webelos - Webelos Walkabout 1, 3, 4 & 6 Bear- Bear Necessities 1b Fur, Feathers & Ferns 1, 2 & 4 are possible. Wolf Adventures -Paws on the Path 1-5 are possible. Tiger - Tigers In The Wild 1, 2 & 3a-c and Lion - Mountain Lion requirements 1-3.

Troop 546 will take your unit's photo, then transport your group from the parking lot to the trailhead.

2	1	Pick up at Skyline Dr. and Turnbull Canyon Rd.
6	3 - 3 1/2	Pick up on Hacienda Blvd. & Buddhist Temple
11	4 - 5	Pick up at Powder Canyon Horse Coral. Parking Lot is located in Powder Canyon off of Harbor Blvd. and Old Fullerton Road, just south of Pathfinder.
