			1. With your family, participate in a flag ceremony. Learn how to properly care for & fold the flag. <b>Requirement 1</b>	2. Participate in a community service project with your family. Plant & care for flowers. Ex. Pg. 48 & 49 <b>Requirement 2</b>	3. Learn about the changes in your community and create a project to show your family how the community has changed. <b>Requirement 4</b>	4. Write down on a piece the following: describe your community, big city? Small town? Is anything different? <b>Requirement 4</b>
5. Look for pictures & stories about your community. Check the internet for these pictures. <b>Requirement 4</b>	6. Wash your hands while singing the “Happy Birthday” song. Use water and soap for 10-15 seconds <b>Requirement 1</b>	7. Play the germ magnet with your family. Wash your hands afterwards. Follow Pg. 233 and explain what you learned about germs <b>Requirement 2</b>	8. Conduct the sneezing demonstration. Show why you should block a sneeze with your elbow. <b>Requirement 3</b>	9. Conduct the mucus demonstration with your family. You’ll be making a big fake mucus. Pgs. 228&229 <b>Requirement 4</b>	10. Grow a mold culture with your family. Show them what formed. Observe the 3 foods daily. Which food grew mold master? <b>Requirement 5</b>	11. Discuss with your parent/guardian what it means to do your duty to God. Discuss your faith. <b>Requirement 1</b>
12. Earn the religious emblem of your faith that is appropriate for your age <b>Requirement 2</b>	13. Offer a prayer, meditation, or reflection with your family. <b>Requirement 3</b>	14. Learn & sing a song that could be sung in reverence before or after meals or one that gives you encouragement. <b>Requirement 5</b>	15. Select a seed, and plant it in a small container. Care for it for 30 days. Take a picture or make a drawing. Steps on Pg. 237 & 238 <b>Requirement 1</b>	16. Find out the growing zone for your area. Different plants require different care. Look at the back of seed packages. <b>Requirement 2</b>	17. Research a botanical or community garden online & learn about two plants that grow there. Share with your family what you learned. <b>Requirement 3</b>	18. Grow a sweet potato plant in water. Push 3 or 4 toothpicks into the sweet potato to make a circle around the middle. Rest the toothpicks on top of the jar with water. <b>Requirement 4C</b>
19. Keep a journal of its growth for two weeks. Place the jar in a window with plenty of sunlight check the water regularly, <b>Requirement 4C</b>	20. Play a game that demonstrates your knowledge of dinosaurs. Read about some of the dinosaurs on Pgs. 193-197 then try to match the clues. <b>Requirement 1</b>	21. Create an imaginary dinosaur. Share with your family its name, what it eats, and where it lives. Use your imagination! <b>Requirement 2</b>	22. Your older family member will give you the signal of when the fun will begin! <b>Requirement 3</b>	23. Make a fossil cast. Roll your clay into a ball and pat it down on a paper plate. Press a leaf into the clay and remove. <b>Requirement 3A</b>	24. Follow the instructions on the package and let your clay dry and harden. Share the fossil cast you made with your family. <b>Requirement 3A</b>	25. Make edible fossil layers. Scoop crushed graham crackers onto flavored gelatin, a layer of animal crackers, graham crackers, pudding <b>Requirement 4</b>
26. Using a map of your own city, locate where you live. <b>Requirement 1A</b>	27. Draw a map for a friend so they can locate your home. Use symbols, buildings, trees etc. <b>Requirement 1B</b>	28. Identify what a compass rose is and where it is. Never Eat a Soggy Waffle! <b>Requirement 2A.</b>	29. Use a compass to identify north. Show how to determine which way is south, east & west <b>Requirement 2B</b>	30. Go on a scavenger hunt using compass and locate an object with a compass. <b>Requirement 3</b>	31. Using a compass, go on a walk you’re your family. Use a map and follow the directions. <b>Requirement 4</b>
