Individual sites or the one group campsite may be reserved online at www.reservecalifornia.com six months in advance. The group campsite is difficult to get as it is quite popular, and the individual sites are small enough that they are only suitable for a Webelos/AOL den event, not an entire pack. 8 people and up to three vehicles are allowed per individual site. The group site is huge and wonderful with its own restroom building, plenty of picnic tables, and a ton of space. There is no weather protection, however, and the site is a short walk (about a block) from the parking area, so all gear must be transported in via walking (wagons recommended).

There are 15 miles of trails in the State Park, including a 5 mile round trip site to the M.A.S.H. site which has informative signs. Rock Pool or Malibu Creek allows for wading in shallow water. A Nature Center is staffed on most weekends.

There are water spigots available throughout the campground. Restroom buildings have multiple doors, each leading to its own stall with a toilet, toilet plus sink, or shower. Sinks are also available external to the building, and showers are coin operated.

The campground is 4 miles from plenty of retail shops near Hwy 101. Nearest fire station is a mile away. Cell phone coverage is fine everywhere. There are individual ADA compliant sites and the restrooms have ADA compliant stalls.
