



# Scout Expo Event Schedule



- **No Overnight Camping** this year due to LA County COVID restrictions.
- **7am - 8am** – Event Team(s) arrival and Setup.
  - Check-in, First Aid, YPT/Safety, Hydration, Flags/Banners, Audio System.
- **8am - 9am** - Unit arrivals, Check-in/Registration, Contest sign-ups, and Unit site setups.
- **9am - 4pm - Day Activities**
  - **9am** – Flags (Raise & Pledge of Allegiance), Scout Oath & Law – Field A
  - **10am** – Contest - “Mess Kit” Toss – Field A
  - **11am** – Contest - Camp Gadget Judging (begins)
  - **12N** – Contest - Campsite Inspection Judging (begins)
  - **1pm** – Contest - Camp Grub Judging – Site B
  - **2pm** – Contest - 10 Essentials Relay Race – Field A
  - **3:30pm** – Flags (Lowering), Dismissal
- **4pm - 5pm** - Clean up and departure.
- **Service and Conservation Projects**
  - Confirm sign-up at Check-in/Registration.





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## Contest Details & Rules:

### “Mess Kit” Toss

- **Contestants must bring their own standard aluminum pie pan and metal dining spoon.**
- Contestants will take turns tossing the pie pan and spoon into a plastic wash tub from a particular distance.
- Those contestants that manage to toss both the pan and spoon go onto the next round. Those that miss the tub for either item is out and joins the spectators to cheer on their friends **IF** at least three contestants make both.
- With each round, the distance gets farther and farther, until it's down to the last individuals.
- If less than 3 contestants make both, then all those who made at least one toss compete in another round until it is down to 1 who has made both or only 1.
- Repeat until 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 1<sup>st</sup> place contestants are awarded.

### Camp Gadget

- Camp gadgets are to be constructed with wooden stakes and rope lashings serving a purpose for the campsite.
- Builders should show the gadget in actual use or be present to describe their gadgets.
- Points are awarded for 1) functionality/usefulness, and 2) design creativity.

### Campsite Inspection

- Campsite Inspections will be conducted using the typical criteria for Camporee campsite inspections at the **Patrol** level.



- Despite no overnight camping, the Patrol campsite should be setup as if there was going to be an overnight stay. That is, include borders, sleeping bags, cooking stations, food coolers/containers (empty is acceptable), gear and equipment boxes, camp gadget, posted documents, first aid kits/markings, tents with ground tarps and fly attached, and any other typical Camporee campsite details expected per the Scouting handbook and Fieldbook.
- Tents with the fly attached should **NOT** be occupied during the Expo due to Covid precautions.
- Gateways are not required for the Patrol Campsite Inspection contest.

### Camp Grub

- Entries must be prepared using a campstove or Dutch oven.
- Entries must contain protein, starch, vegetable/fruit, and dairy in the recommended “My Plate” proportions.
- **Prepare and bring your food to Site B for Judging between 1pm and 1:15pm.**
- Entries will not be accepted earlier or later than the specified window for judging.
- Please wait until your entry has been accepted by the Judges and identified as your submission before departing.
- Entries will be judged equally on 1) Meeting the My Plate proportions, 2) Taste, and 3) Appearance.

### 10 Essentials Relay Race

- **Teams of 4 relay racers** will participate in a relay race where instead of a baton, each racer will have to pull out a 10 essential



item from their backpack based on a list of 4 items the first member of their team has been given at the starting line.

- Once they pull out the item, they will race to the next member of their team (with their backpack).
- When they reach their next team member, they are handed the list and 10 essential item(s) already pulled, where they need to pull the next item on the list from their own 10 Essentials before racing to their next team member to pass off the list again and all the items pulled so far.
- The racer for the final leg of the relay will repeat the process for the last item on the list and race to cross the finish line first to turn in the list and all 4 Essentials that were pulled.

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
