<u>NEW YOUTH PROTECTION MEASURES</u> California Law AB506 requires youth serving organizations to take certain steps to protect children. See GLAAC announcement <u>HERE</u>. BSA Councils across the state are collaborating to support this effort, and have created <u>this website</u>, including a very useful <u>FAQ</u>. GLAAC's goal is to have all registered Scouters take <u>training</u> and upload their certificates by 1 March 2022. Implementation for Live Scan is TBA.

The new form includes a checklist of all the documentation required to successfully complete an application. A Google account is required to upload your application forms. If you do not have a Google account, or need help obtaining supporting documents, please contact your unit's Merit Badge Counselor Coordinator or Advancement Chair for assistance.
