WOOD BADGE

Course Description

Wood Badge is a 5-day course, broken into two weekends. ***You must attend both weekends and complete your "ticket" to finish this course.***

The first weekend is presented in a classroom setting, and participants will lodge in cabins. Topics will include leadership styles and techniques, problem solving, conflict management, effective communications, and much, much more.

The second weekend is an outdoor experience, with participants camping participating in more physical activities that leverage the team building skills acquired in the first weekend.

Course Requirements/Expenses

- Cost per participant is \$295, payment in full at time of registration
- This course will take a total of 48 participants.
- All County Health rules will be observed, and additional COVID prevention measures will be in place.
- Participants must be registered members of the Boy Scouts of America age 18 or older.
- Participants must have completed the basic training courses for their Scouting position.
- Participants **MUST** be capable of functioning safely in an outdoor environment.
